PREPARING THE EXTERIOR

- Move vehicles from the driveway
- Remove any clutter (bins, tools etc)
- Remove dead plants & leaves
- · Mow the lawn
- Clean doors, windows, driveway, patio & garden furniture
- · Close doors & windows



PREPARING RECEPTION ROOMS & BEDROOMS

- · Open curtains & blinds
- Make beds thoroughly
- Plump up cushions
- Remove clutter from under the bed
- Close all cupboards
- Store kids toys etc out of sight



PREPARING THE KITCHEN

- Clear worktops & empty the sink
- Hide towels
- Move bins, pet bowls & pet bedding out of sight
- Close all cupboards

PREPARING BATHROOMS

- · Toilet lids to be left down
- Clear counter tops, removing toiletries
- · Pull back shower curtains
- Remove towels from rails or radiators
- Ensure toilet roll and brushes are presentable
